

**2017 International Practical Shooting Confederation (IPSC-NB) of New Brunswick Inc.
(IPSC NB) Report**

My name is Richard Telesnicki, I was elected section coordinator for IPSC NB in August of this year replacing Dianne Gould. We currently have 150 members and this past year put on 4 Black Badge courses bringing in 40 new members to the sport.

Many IPSC matches have been held in numerous clubs throughout the Province with St. Croix and Woodstock showing growing numbers in the IPSC shooting sport. IPSC had a few members attend the Canadian Nationals this year in Alberta and also some who shot matches in Nova Scotia.

This was the first year that we broke up the provincials into four divisions Open Standard Production and revolver. This seemed to be a success allowing competitors to take part in more than one provincial tournament and division.

The 2018 season is looking up with Summer Slam, the SNB250 and Provincials being planned already. There is also exciting talk of the first sanctioned IPSC shotgun and rifle matches being held in New Brunswick.
