Membership :

Membership at this time consists of 15 youth with another 5 girls scheduled to begin next week in pistol shooting.

Competition Schedule:

On November 5th there are two shoots scheduled for the same day. Nova Scotia will be hosting their Provincial Championships in Dartmouth, N.S. Two of our shooters, Alyssa Gidney and Emily Dean, both of St. Stephen, have signed up for this match which will take place over two days. The notice for the N.S. competition was sent out by Ray Fisher to all those who training for the last Canada Games. He has had no responses from Sackville, Woodstock or any areas other than St. Stephen.

A non-title shoot will also be held in Augusta, Maine on the same date.

Emily Dean is now a member of the 2018 National team and is one of only two shooters in Canada to make the cut score.

Range Facility:

We are still located in the Boys and Girls Club, but are now crowded to a point where we are unable to host competitions as we have done in the past. We are still actively seeking new quarters that will allow us to do Round Robin shoots with Newfoundland, Nova Scotia and Quebec.
